

Tokoroa High School Fashion & Wonderland Wearable Arts Show 2020

Design and create a wearable art garment that is innovative, original and captures the imagination and the attention of our audience.

Entry Guide

Please read: The entry guide and the categories guide carefully before you start creating your garment. Entry forms must be received at THS **no later** than the 1st of July 2020.

The Garment:

Garments must be safe to wear. No sharp edges or items that could cause bodily harm to models, designers or backstage staff permitted.

Garments need to be constructed so they can be taken on and off without too much difficulty. Garments should not be too heavy, unbalanced or uncomfortable and should hold together.

Garment Size - No more than 2m wide or 2m high. The costume must also be able to go up stairs.

Completed garments (including accessory parts) must be able to be carried, pushed, and supported by the model alone.

We can supply models: please advise us of the model size required when returning your entry form.

The garments must be completed and available for the **first rehearsal** which will be held on the 6th of August from 5pm to 9pm at the Tokoroa High School.

Garments and models must also be available for the Award night performance on Friday the 7th of August from 4pm-11pm.

Other Conditions:

You cannot enter the same wearable art garment into more than one category. Each entry has a non-refundable entry fee.

This is a community event attracting a large audience. Standards acceptable in the general community will be upheld. The organiser reserves the right to refuse any entrant to take part in any or all aspects of the event if the organiser determines, at their discretion, that the entrant, model or garment is not suitable.

Prizes are not transferable.

The organisers reserve the right, at the discretion, to use the winners' name, address, and photographs of the garments, models and/or designers for promotional purposes.

Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. In a dispute over which category and entry will be judged in, the organising committee's decision is final.

Student entrants will remain the responsibility of their parent/caregiver at all times during the event and in the lead-up to the event.

The winner for the open section (mad hatter) is a stand-alone prize winner. Which means the winner of this section will not be among the finalists for the supreme award. The supreme award winner will be selected from the overall winners of the other categories ONLY.

Disclosure is necessary if the creation has entered another competition.

All Rules and Conditions are subject to change at the discretion of Tokoroa High School.

Categories

Primary and Intermediate

Recycled

Use recyclable materials, that would normally be seen as waste, to design and create a wearable art that can be worn by an individual.

Wonderland

Go wild! Create an innovative and original fantasy wonderland inspired by your imagination.

Secondary Schools

Culture

A wearable art that is designed and created to be worn by an individual. The wearable art can reflect any culture/s around the world. The wearable art can depict styles or techniques utilising non-traditional materials.

Wonderland

Go wild! Create an innovative and original fantasy wonderland inspired by your imagination. The wearable art will be shown and displayed under white light only and must be worn by an individual.

Back to the future

An opportunity to dream about how the future might be and create something to wear and stun us all.

Mad Hatter

Using your imagination, create and design a hat that captivates the audience – any size, any theme and material that can be worn by an individual.
